Riding Rules

Check-in:

- Entry fees are due and waivers must be signed **upon arrival** for all persons prior to entering the park.
- A VALID government-issued photo ID, which includes your name, signature, photo, and date of birth is required to prove that you are 18 years or older and able to sign your own waiver (e.g., driver's license or passport).
- Any participant under 18 years of age (child) **MUST** have a waiver signed by their parent or legal guardian. If the parent or legal guardian will not be attending the event with the child, that child's waiver must be printed and **notarized** to permit entry into the park. If the parent or legal guardian is not attending the event, the child must remain with the adult responsible for them at all times, and this adult must be 18 years or older. If the parent, legal guardian, or adult responsible for the child needs to exit the park for any reason, the child **MUST** leave with them. **No exceptions!!**
- Each person admitted to the park must get their own wristband.
- A VALID government-issued photo ID, which includes your name, signature, photo, and date of birth, is required to be issued a wristband that indicates that you are 21 years or older (e.g., driver's license, passport, concealed carry permit). All others will be issued a different wristband.
- Wristbands **MUST** be worn on your wrist at all times.
- You must have your wristband on your wrist for re-entry if you leave the park.

Alcoholic beverages:

- You **MUST** be of legal age (21 years or older) to possess and/or consume alcohol while at the park.
- People under 21 years of age (minors) are not allowed to possess or consume alcohol while at the park. All state alcohol laws apply. If a minor is caught drinking and/or in possession of alcohol:
 - Alcohol will be confiscated.
 - Minor (and responsible adult/parent/guardian if applicable) may be arrested.
 - Minor (and responsible adult/parent/guardian if applicable) may be expelled or banned from the park.
- Alcohol is **ONLY** allowed if you are camping, and it **MUST** be kept at the campsite.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO** consumption of alcohol on the trails.
- **NO** glass bottles.
- Remember, **DRINKING AND DRIVING IS ILLEGAL.**

Equipment:

- ATV/dirt bike riders are recommended to have their own helmet with them at sign-in.
- Flags are required on **ALL** ATVs, especially in the Mud Field around the Big Trucks. Have your flags with you at sign in.
- All ATV drivers must be a licensed driver (16 and older) after dusk.
- All **DRIVERS** under the age of 16 must have a parent/guardian present.

Camping Areas:

- No parking or camping within 30 feet of any road. This will help keep traffic clear and moving when people are entering or exiting the park.
- Quiet time in REID FIELD from midnight until 7:00 a.m.
- ABSOLUTELY NO racing or donuts in the camping fields.
- Idle speed (5 mph) in all camp areas.

Trails:

- NO trailblazing allowed. Stay on designated trails.
- NO riding in creeks.
- Cross creeks at designated crossings ONLY. DO NOT stop at the creek crossings. Please keep it moving.
- 10 MPH speed on main roads.
- Be courteous to other drivers. Remember, ATVs, dirtbikes, etc. may not be easily visible to drivers in larger vehicles...especially when in very close proximity.
- NO donuts (or other aggressive riding that throws dirt/grass) in any areas other than at mud pit area.
- Stay within the boundaries of the park.

Miscellaneous:

- NO bolted tires.
- NO firearms.
- NO illegal drugs.
- NO fires except in designated areas in the camping area.
- NO fireworks.
- NO hunting.
- Fighting will NOT be tolerated. Fighting may lead to: arrest, expulsion, and/or ban from the property.
- RESPECT the land that you are riding on, all structures, the owners, and event volunteers at all times.
- Please direct any questions/concerns to owners or ask event volunteers to connect you with a The Ridge Off-Road Park Staff member.
- Please be aware of local, state, and federal laws regarding trailer height, width and weight, restrictions, and regulations.
- DO NOT LITTER. Please take all trash to the dumpster or trash barrels nearest you. Trash bags are available upon request at the front office.

Pets:

- Pets are allowed under the following conditions:
 - Must be leashed
 - Must have current shots/vaccinations
- Owners are 100% responsible for their pets and their actions.
- Owners must pick up / clean up after their pets.
- Irresponsible pet owners will be asked to leave.

As of right now, we do NOT rent machines/equipment. Come prepared with your own machines/equipment.
